Review of grassland habitats of the EUNIS habitats classification

- Brief description of aims and methods of the study:

Commissioned by the European Environment Agency a study will be conducted to determine the floristic composition and European distribution of EUNIS habitat grassland types. More specifically it concerns the habitat group E of EUNIS (Grasslands) as well as grasslands included under habitat group B (B1.4 Coastal stable dune grassland and B1.9 Machair). Grasslands are of great importance in European nature policy, of widespread distribution, housing a large proportion of the biodiversity in this part of the world, and everywhere under threat. The existing descriptions are insufficient and inadequately supported by in situ vegetation data which limit the usability of the EUNIS habitat classification. A considerable part of the work will also be the maintenance and extension of the EVA database.
