- Brief description of aims and methods of the study:

Providing a red list of all European habitat types following the typology of (about) Eunis level 3. For this we need a distribution map per habitat type, on a 10x10 km grid scale. We would like to make use of all EVA relevés since 1975 that have been georeferenced. We will compile the EU distribution maps by selecting certain species combinations (maybe in combination with additional GIS layer, for instance `coast'). No individual relevés will be published or used in other ways. Besides EVA-data, we will use other sources (f.i. habitat maps, HD Article 17-data) to make these EU maps. In the final EU maps it will be indicated whether the data is derived from EVA or from any other source.

- Will someone else be involved in data editing or analysis in addition to the applicant?

Only colleagues within Alterra. Note that all EVA coordinating board members (Chytrý, Landucci, Hennekens, Dengler, Jansen, Schaminée) have a role in the European Red List of Habitats project, and may guarantee the correct use of EVA data rules.
