We map distribution of alien species *Sedum hispanicum* in the Czech Republic and sample phytosociological relevés with this species (so far, 59 in Turboveg database). For the synecological overview, also data from Europe are needed.

- Estimated time of delivery of results (e.g. manuscript submission):

- Geographic area needed (e.g. countries or range of geographic coordinates):

It is hard to localize potential geographic area. The distribution range should cover all the European states from Alps and Italy including Sicily through eastern (sub)mediterranean part of the Europe (especially Balkan Peninsula) to Anatolia, Near East (Lebanon, Palestine, Jordan) including the Arabian peninsula, Caucasus and north Iran. The species is also reported from Turkmenistan, Iraq, Afghanistan and Pakistan. The European northern distribution limit runs through Switzerland, Eastern Alps, Hungary and Eastern Carpathians. Surprisingly no data are reported from Poland. The species is widely cultivated and also naturalized in Central and Western Europe, in Scandinavia and in all of Baltic countries. The secondary occurrence of *S. hispanicum* is also known from northwestern Russia.
