- METHODS (description of sampling design and methods): Original data were sampled in the late 1980s for the diploma thesis by M. Chytrý, which focused on a phytosociological classification of dry grasslands. Plots were placed selected subjectively within homogeneous vegetation stands and had different sizes and shapes. The sampling was repeated by M. Harásek, under the supervision of M. Chytrý, in 2018-2019. Some plots were repeated only once, and others were repeated using two or three new plots (especially if there was higher uncertainty about the location of the original plot.
- ENVIRONMENTAL DATA (list of environmental data measured):
 Soil pH was measured in the plots from 2018-2019 (from mineral soil, depth of 5-10 cm, measurement in a distilled water suspension).
