METHODS (description of sampling design and methods):

Recording all vascular plant species rooted within the plot with covers visually estimated using the modified nine-degree Braun-Blanquet scale. Altogether seven permanent plots of 4×4 m2, marked by metal rods, were established in 1993 and since then recorded annually in May (except for 1995).
