- METHODS (description of sampling design and methods):
 - The former Milovice military training area (Czech Republic), later Site of European Community Importance (SCI) Milovice-Mladá and later classified a National Nature Monument Mladá remained unmanaged for 25 years (1990–2015) – homogenization by grases, ruderal forbs and shrubs. Since 2015 two parts were grazed by semi wild herds of horses, semi-wild cattle and European bison.
 - In June 2017 established 30 monitoring plots inside the grazed areas (15 in the Southern and 15 in the Northern area) and In June 2018 5 control plots outside the grazed area.
 - Recorded vascular plant species and visually estimated their percentage cover once per year at the peak of vegetation season (June/July) in 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2021.
