- METHODS (description of sampling design and methods):

The method consists of setting up a temporal socio-ecological profile (PSET) in the field, a permanent sequence made up of several segments, corresponding to a given surface, delimited and geo-referenced, in which vegetation surveys are carried out with abundance coefficients (Braun-Blanquet old or new), over time.
A GPS point is made at each end of the profile sequences and a metal terminal (or magnet) is also driven into the ground. Floristic surveys are carried out along the profile with an equivalent spacing (0.5m, 1m...) for all the sequences of the profile.
