- METHODS (description of sampling design and methods):

Survey id done in 7 transects in lake Bohinj, in each transect, macrophyte presence and abundance is assessed. Macrophyte species abundance is estimated as a relative plant biomass using a five-degree scale: 1 = very rare; 2 = rare; 3 = common; 4 = frequent; 5 = abundant, predominant (Kohler, 1978; Kohler and Janauer, 1995). Survey is preformed from the boat, using a rake with the hooks.

- ENVIRONMENTAL DATA (list of environmental data measured):
 - GPS point at the middle of the transect (6m wide), length of the transect, changes in bank, shore vegetation, land use, slope of the bottom. In each depth zone: m-m, type of sediment and abundance of the species.
 - Physical and chemical parameters of the water (pH, temperature, oxgen (mg/L), oxygen (saturation), electric conductivity
- MANIPULATED PLOTS (description of the treatment if the plots were manipulated, e.g. mowing twice a year, fertilizing by NPK once a year, post-fire succession)

Lake is not manipulated; some tourism and highland pasture in catchment; it is located in Triglav national Park and all activities are forbidden.
