- METHODS (description of sampling design and methods):

Original data from 1981-1983, resurveyed in 2025; 24 plots

Grid sampling design, Piskernik method: the relevés are 7 x 7 m squares (49 m²); abundance scale: e – 1 specimen, r – 2-5 specimens, + – 6-10 specimens, x – 11 specimens to 10 % coverage, 1 – 11-20 % coverage, 2 – 21-40 % coverage, 3 – 41-60 % coverage, 4 – 61-80 % coverage, 5 – 81-100 % coverage;

In 2025, in addition to the Piskernik method, we also used the Braun-Blanquet method on the same, but larger (20 x 20 m), sampling plots.
