as previously announced, the 9th EVS Workshop will be held in Erice, Western Sicily from April 6 to April 10, 2000. It is planned to have a larger excursion in Sicily in the following days and to reach the International Airport of Palermo Punta Raisi at Wednesday 12 April, in time for the late flights.

Travel information: participants coming by airplane have to reach the Palermo Airport during the morning of April 6 (please, indicate the exact travel schedule which is necessary to organize the courtesy transfer to Erice). A bus will bring the participants to a short visit of the town of Palermo. At ca. 17.00 the bus will go for a second time to the Airport and pick up people arriving in the afternoon and then travel to Erice. Participants coming by train can reach the Botanical Gardens and join the other group: please indicate the time of arrival, a car will bring you to the Gardens.

Return from the larger excursion at April 12 will be first in the Airport and then at the Railway Station in time for the late flights and trains.

The price for one day (accommodation, breakfast, lunch, and dinner in typical sicilian "trattorie") is about lire 130.000-150.000 for person. Rooms for 1 (only a few) or 2 persons. The excursion of Sunday is offered. For the larger excursion possibly a contribution will be requested. No inscription fee for the Workshop.
